

## Named CIO Scholarships

**Who is eligible to apply?** Current CHIME members and their direct reports

**Award: \$1,500** toward education related to improving in any of the *CHIME Seven CIO Success Factor(s)* as taught in the Healthcare CIO Boot Camp (*includes registration fees/tuition, and travel costs to attend\**).

### Application Details

The Named CIO Scholarships are funded by generous donations from CHIME members and other executives who have a vested interest in the education and professional development of CIOs in the healthcare industry. The scholarships are aimed at supporting CIOs in improving their skills as IT leaders at their organization and increasing their proficiency in CHIME's *Seven CIO Success Factors*.

*\*Hotel rooms will be covered only for the duration of the education event.*

### Applicant criteria

- Must report to or be a current CHIME member.

### Application materials required

1. Completed application form: Candidates must answer all of the questions on the application related to the *CHIME CIO Seven Success Factors* that are taught in the Healthcare CIO Boot Camp.
2. Essay: After identifying which Success Factor(s) the applicant needs the most improvement in, using the application form, describe a professional development/education plan for how to achieve proficiency in that Success Factor (s). Essay should be no longer than two pages.

Essay should explain:

- a. What actions the applicant would take to improve in the area(s) identified; include the program listed for question number four on the application form.
  - b. How improvement in the Success Factor(s) would help the applicant's organization.
  - c. How improvement in the Success Factor(s) would help fulfill his/her professional development goals.
3. Resume: Scholarship candidates should provide a current resume highlighting their experience and/or achievements in the healthcare IT field.
